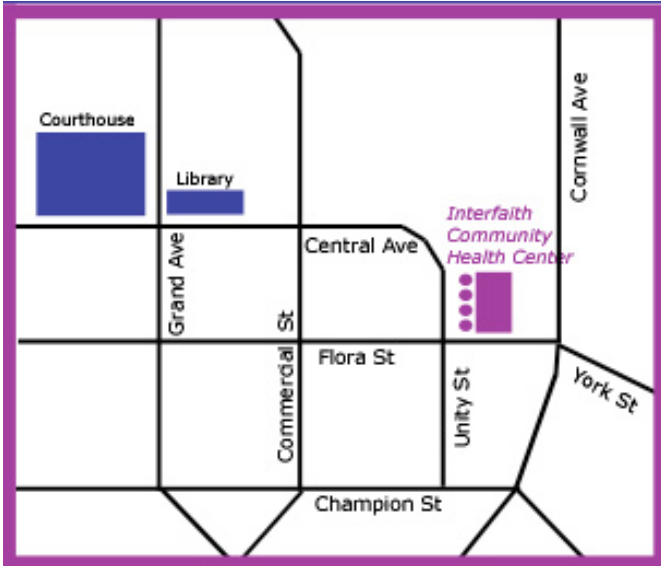

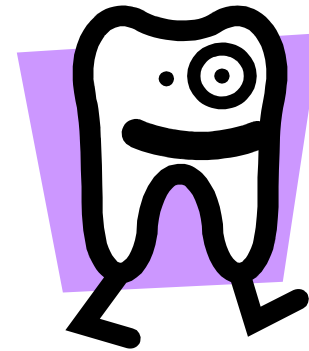

Five Things To Know About Dental Pain and Getting Care

The Hospital Emergency Department cannot schedule appointments or make routine dental referrals to the community health centers.

Five Things to Know if You Have Dental Pain...

1. Dental pain is usually the result of tooth decay. If left untreated, decay can cause pain and sometimes infection.
2. Immediate treatment can include over-the-counter medication to reduce pain and swelling, and sometimes antibiotics for infection.
3. Follow-up treatment can include extraction (pulling) or restoration (drilling and filling) of decayed tooth.
4. The Hospital Emergency Department cannot make routine dental referrals to the community health centers.
5. Brushing twice daily with fluoridated toothpaste, flossing, and avoiding sugary foods and drinks are good ways to prevent dental disease in the future.

Interfaith and Sea Mar Community Health Centers invite you to *walk-in for urgent dental care*:



- **Arrive by:** 8:00 a.m.
- **Limited availability:** There are a limited number of openings for people in need. If you are willing to wait – with **no guarantee** – they will try and work you in during the day.
- **Payment is expected at time of service:** Sliding fee and payment plan arrangements can be made.
- **Care is on a one time basis:** Interfaith and Sea Mar hold no obligation to provide ongoing dental care to people who access the “walk-in urgent dental care” program.
